

## Verse 2


All my life I have been called unworthy

## "The Second Chance or Renewal and Restoration"

- 51** <sup>10</sup> Create in me a clean heart, O God,  
And renew a steadfast spirit within me.  
<sup>11</sup> Do not cast me away from Your presence,  
And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me.  
<sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of Your salvation,  
And uphold me *by Your* generous Spirit.  
<sup>13</sup> *Then* I will teach transgressors Your ways,  
And sinners shall be converted to You.
- <sup>16</sup> For You do not desire sacrifice, or else I would give *it*;  
You do not delight in burnt offering.  
<sup>17</sup> The sacrifices of God *are* a broken spirit,  
A broken and a contrite heart—  
These, O God, You will not despise.

**Psalms 51: 10 – 13; 16 – 17 NKJV**

**Intro:** Psalm 51 is a great psalm of personal repentance and confession. It is also a great psalm of personal renewal and restoration. The first part of the psalm deals with the first steps of a personal revival that begins with repentance and confession. Repentance and confession provide a clean slate. Once the slate is clean, what is next?

The second part of Psalm 51 provides the answer to that question. Once David repented and confessed, he placed his sins in God's hands. These sins are in the past and have been erased, now what? Now he needs a second chance to live a godly life. This comes by way of renewal and restoration.

David turned to God to be renewed and restored. This renewal includes a "clean heart" and a "right spirit." He also asks God to restore "the joy of Your salvation" and asks to be used by Him to "teach transgressors Your ways." David also realizes the sacrifices that God desires "are a broken spirit, a broken and contrite heart."

Today we will look at the second part of Psalm 51 and at this second chance God provides for us: **"The Second Chance of Renewal and Restoration."**



I. For a Second Chance, We Turn to God for Renewal (10; 16-17)

It is Inner Renewal “Create in me a clean heart”

It is Spiritual Renewal “Renew a steadfast spirit within me”

It leads to True Worship “You do not desire sacrifice, or else I would give it... the sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, a broken and contrite heart”

II. For a Second Chance, We Turn to God for Restoration (11-13)

He Restores Our Fellowship “Do not cast me away from Your presence”

He Restores Our Joy “Restore to me the joy of your salvation”

He Restores Our Influence “the I will teach transgressors Your ways”

He Restores Our Witness “sinners will be converted to You.”
